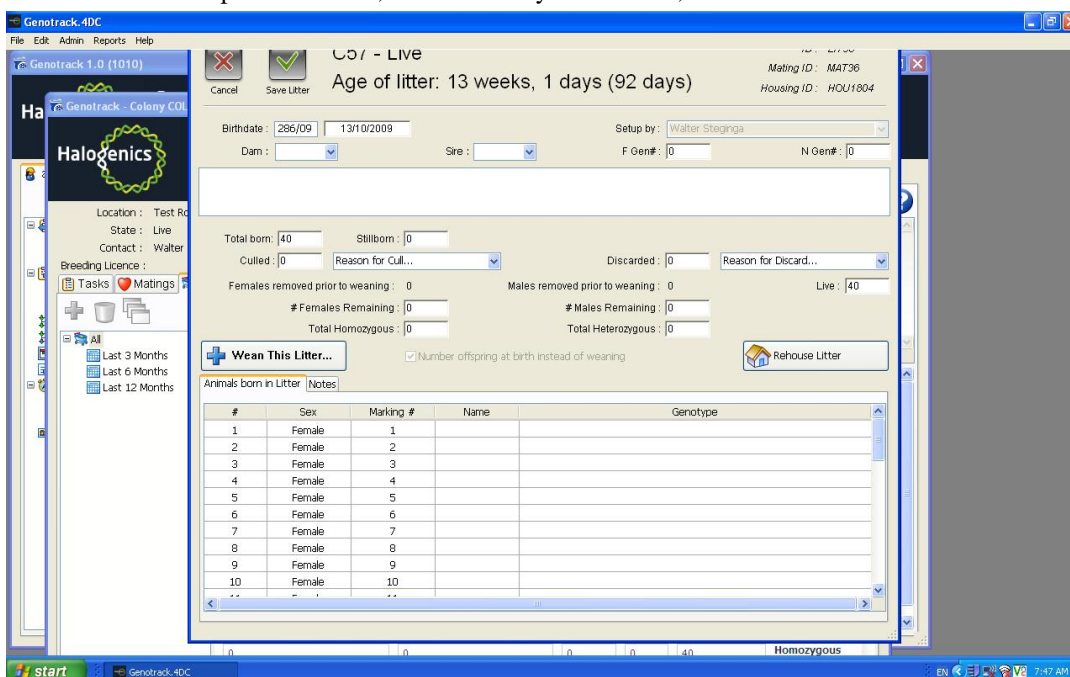

Repositioning a window when the title bar is hidden

How to move the immovable window

When running on Windows, you may sometimes find a window open where the upper part of the window is off the top of the screen, or obscured by the title bar, as shown below:



The litter window, positioned with the upper part of the window obscured.

Ordinarily, you would reposition the window by clicking in the title bar of the window and dragging it to the new location, but with the upper part of the window hidden, this is not possible.

Fortunately, there is a keyboard and mouse combination you can use to move the window.

To move the window, position the mouse pointer over the content part of the window (not over the frame - anywhere inside the frame is fine) and then hold down Control+Shift then click and hold Left Button+Right Button and drag the window to the new position.
